

Ledizioni-AcaBarCamp 2008 Prize

Art. 1 – General Informations

Ledizioni, Libreria Ledi International Bookseller publishing division, together with Librishop.it, issues the first edition of “Ledizioni-AcaBarCamp” Prize. Ledizioni will publish, with no author expenses, two monographs both in print and digital edition, in Italian or English language, authored or edited by conference’s attendees.

Digital Edition will be distributed for free according to the principles of the Open Access movement. It will be posted into ledizioni website and any other subject repository that the publisher or the authors will find suitable. The books will be copyright protected by a Creative Commons license “Attribution-Noncommercial 3.0 Unported”.

Art. 2 – Committee

The Committee that will examine the submissions will be chaired by Ledizioni publishing director and will be constituted by university professors and new media experts.

Art. 3 – Selection criteria

Submitted works will be judged according to an open peer review process among the commission members. Each member will review each work submitted and will then present a review of the work. Ledizioni publishing director will chair the meeting and will decide, according to members reviews and opinions, which books to publish.

Art. 4 – Requisiti di ammissione e domanda di partecipazione

The application letter, sent by email to info@ledizioni.it, should arrive by October 24th. Confirmation receipt will be sent by return email. If you do not receive a confirmation within 48 hours, please resend your application.

The application letter should clearly state:

- a) name and surname, date and place of birth, home and office address, a phone number and the email address.
- b) A declaration stating that Ledizioni is authorized to treat your personal data
- c) The provisional title of your monograph and the editorial condition, choose within:

- 1) finished, proof reading done
- 2) finished, proof reading to be done
- 3) provisional

You should attach to your application:

- a) an abstract of the monograph (not more than 600 words);
- b) a digital copy of the full text;
- c) a curriculum vitae, with all details to evaluate your scientific career; In case of an edited monograph we require the curriculum vitae of the editor only.
